How does LPA use your membership fee?

Last summer our dedicated volunteers collected lake water samples from both Lake Poinsett and Lake Albert. Water quality data provides valuable concrete information, and it is how we help protect our lake. The state lab analyzes our samples, and the results can be found on the LPA website.

A cost-share initiative with Game Fish and Parks purchased new Aquatic Invasive Species Awareness signs (AIS). These signs will be placed at boat launches around Lake Poinsett, Lake Albert, Lake Norden, and Lake St John. These signs raise AIS awareness on our lake and the lakes that flow into Poinsett. We want to keep our lake AIS free!
