

ORDINANCE NO. 1-90

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING DOG REGULATIONS FOR THE AREA ENCOMPASSING THAT PORTION OF THE LAKE POINSETT SANITARY DISTRICT LOCATED WITHIN HAMLIN COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY HAMLIN COUNTY:

The following regulations shall apply to the area encompassing that portion of the Lake Poinsett Sanitary District located within Hamlin County, South Dakota.

Dogs Running at Large. No person owning, keeping or having charge of any dog shall permit such dog to run at large off the premises of such person. All dogs shall be securely tied or otherwise limited or confined to the premises of their owner, keeper or person having charge thereof, or shall be under the immediate control of such person.

Dogs on Recreation Areas. Dogs shall not be permitted on any public recreation areas unless controlled by a leash.

Vicious Dogs. The owner of a vicious dog, as defined by SDCL 40-34-14, shall not allow such dog to go beyond the premises of the owner unless the dog is securely muzzled and restrained by a chain or leash.

Dog Kennels. Kennels must be clean and sanitary, and shall not be allowed to become stagnant or a nuisance.

Defecation. No person owning, keeping or having charge of any dog shall allow such dog to defecate upon public or private property, and should such defecation occur, such person must immediately and thoroughly clean the fecal material from such property.

Penalty. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
